The admission process at MDI is a two stage.

Stage 1(short listing): The short listing for WAT-GD-PI of candidates is done on the basis of CAT-2016 percentiles including sectional cut offs from eligible application pool of MDI, Gurgaon. The minimum CAT-2016 percentile requirement is decided based on the number of candidates to be shortlisted . The number of candidates to be shortlisted is decided as per admissions policy of MDI.

Stage 2 (WAT-GD-PI): The shortlisted candidates will go through the following process:

1. Written Analysis Test (WAT): Candidates have to submit a written analysis on the topic provided. The evaluation of WAT will be on content and language.
2. Group Discussion (GD): Candidates have to discuss the same topic in group discussion. The evaluation of GD will be on group behavior and content.
3. Personal Interview: Thereafter candidates have to appear for personal interview. The evaluation will be on communication, analytical ability, general aptitude and business awareness.

The merit list is prepared by considering CAT-2016 scores, Application score and WAT-GD-PI Score.

The WAT-GD-PI starts from mid Feb, 2017 in Gurgaon, Mumbai, Kolkata, Bangalore, Hyderabad and Chennai.
