The non-residential Executive Fellow Programme in Management caters to the scholarly needs of working business executives. It prepares executives for careers in management teaching and research, as well as in management practice, consulting and development

Continuing Education

MDI is the largest school for continuing education in the country. To cater to the need for continuous upgradation of individual and organizational capabilities, MDI offers both general and customized in-company programmes to public and private sectors and to several government and non government organizations and departments. During 2013-14, MDI conducted a total of 136 training programmes, benefitting 3051 managers and civil servants of Indian nationality and 250 managers of foreign nationalities. Of these 176 participants were trained abroad in Europe and the US.

HIGHLIGHTS OF 2013-14

Global Conference

MDI hosted the first global conference in the series of 13 global conferences planned for 2014, 2015 and 2016 on the theme "Managing in Recovering Markets" during 5-7 March, 2014. This conference was held in association with Australian Centre for Asian Business, University of South Australia, Adelaide and Faculty of Economics & Business, University of Maribor, Slovenia. H.E. Mrs. Darja Bavdaz Kuret, Ambassador of the Republic of Slovenia to India inaugurated the conference.

116 national and international papers on various themes capturing ideas of 203 academicians were accepted for the conference. The selective proceedings of the conference would be published in a special issue of GCMRM by leading international publisher "SPRINGER".

MDI International Summer University

As a way of effectively discharging its corporate social responsibility, MDI launched the International Summer University in 2013. This was the first of its kind in India. The primary objective was to offer an opportunity to students from Indian universities and business schools to study alongside overseas students from faculty seconded by our overseas partner schools. The first edition of the MDI-ISU was successfully conducted from end-April to mid-June 2013. Nine courses were taught and more than 90 enrollments were done in the very first year.

The MDI – ISU 2014 is scheduled to commence from 28th April and end on 12th June 2014. Registrations from our Indian network of universities and business schools as well as from overseas partner schools are streaming in.
