The selection of candidates for admission to the 2026-2028 batch of the PGDM-BFS (Banking and Financial Services) at MDI Gurgaon would be a two-stage process. The first stage will be the shortlisting of candidates for the WAT-GD-PI process from a complete pool of applicants for admissions up to the last date of form submission. Criteria for Stage-I shortlisting are given in Table-1, and updated criteria for final ranking in Stage-II are given in Table 2.

Regional diversity	2.50% (Candidates from North-East and Jammu & Kashmir)
Sports	2.50% (Only for National and International level competitions)
