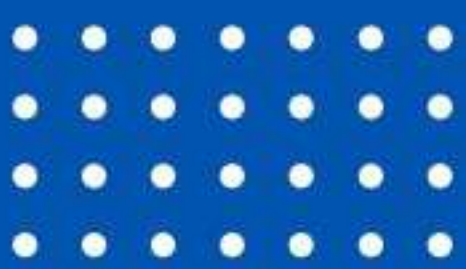

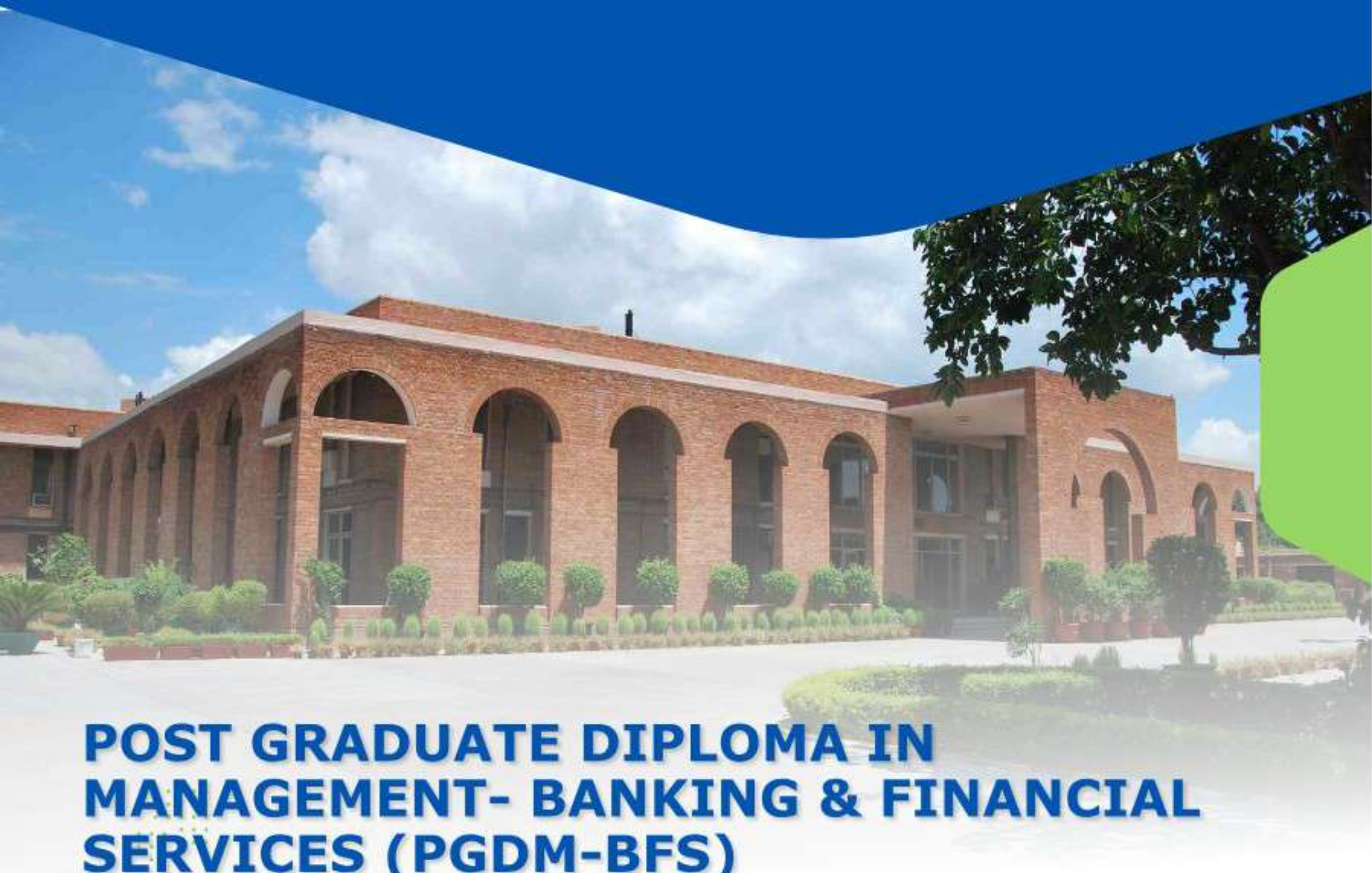

POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN MANAGEMENT- BANKING & FINANCIAL SERVICES (PGDM-BFS)

MDI Gurgaon, under its new School of Management of Financial Institutions (SoMFI), proposes to launch its flagship 2-year, Full-Time, residential Post Graduate Diploma in Management in Banking and Financial Services (PGDM-BFS) from the forthcoming academic year 2026-27 at the MDI Gurgaon campus. PGDM-BFS will target fresh graduates and working professionals with under three years' experience who aspire to build their careers in the banking and financial services domain, including Commercial, Retail, and Investment Banking, Risk Management, BFS Consulting, Fintech, Asset Management, Quantitative Finance, and Financial Markets. The primary differentiation of PGDM-BFS is an in-depth coverage of banking and finance domain knowledge and skillsets, electives benchmarked to BFS industry needs, specialization tracks mapped to career opportunities in the BFS industry, curated and co-created in collaboration with leading Indian and global academic and industry partners.

The School of Management of Financial Institutions (SoMFI) was established by MDI Gurgaon in 2022 to offer education, training, research, and consulting services in the banking and financial institutions domain. The School emphasizes the needs of emerging markets, with a primary focus on India and South Asian

countries. SoMFI offers a range of academic programs that are research-led and industry-driven, ensuring that participants receive high-quality education and practical training in banking and financial services. It also engages in corporate trainings, consulting and knowledge sharing through conferences.

To power the School's offerings with rigorous research, The Centre for Financial Services, was established under SoMFI in 2025. This centre undertakes research in finance, economics, and relevant applications of behavioural science in this domain. These include, but are not limited to, policy formulation, business strategy, regulation, and operational issues across banking, insurance, mutual funds, wealth management, pensions, financial advisory services, fintech, and NBFCs. The Centre carries out its research through close engagement with industry stakeholders, academia, and policymakers.

The key focus of SoMFI is the development of future leaders in the Banking and Financial Services sector, with particular emphasis on boardroom leadership development, technology awareness, and corporate governance.

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

- The programme is spread over six terms of three months each. The core courses are covered in the first three terms. These courses are designed, structured, & curated to impart a blend of functional, domain, and technical competencies essential for specialized career paths in the BFS sector.
- The first year culminates in a compulsory industry internship of 8-10 weeks.
- During the three terms in the second year, students can opt for a combination of major, minor and free electives. Students can specialize in one or two tracks; minimum six electives (or 18 credits) including track core courses & minimum four electives (or 12 credits) are required to secure a major and minor respectively. Students will complete between fourteen to seventeen courses in the second year, that includes a compulsory dissertation or capstone.
- Besides credit courses, the programme offers 11 specialized, workshop-mode modules for holistic development related to job - skilling or values-based of 10 hours each. The workshop courses are evaluative & have a minimum performance requirement to qualify for PGDM-BFS
- Partnering with industry, the programme aims to impart at least 20% of the classroom teaching by industry experts.

ADMISSION & SELECTION PROCESS (2026-28)

Students shortlisted on the basis of their application details and CAT 2025 scores are invited to give their preference for the PGDM (BFS) if they have an inclination and interest to make a career in banking, fintech, asset management, wealth management, private equity and venture capital, insurance, and related fields.

Those pursuing or holding qualifications such as CA/ ICWA/ CFA/FRM are encouraged to apply. With banking and financial services becoming more tech- and data-driven, candidates possessing degrees in Engineering, Computer Science, Mathematics, Physics and Statistics may be good fits in the future of banking and financial services. If you have prior work experience in the BFS sector, you may be a good fit for this programme.

For candidates invited for Group Discussion (GD), Written Aptitude Test (WAT) and Personal Interview (PI), the selection process will be conducted between February and April 2026. The interview centres include Bengaluru, Gurugram, Kolkata, Hyderabad and Mumbai.

Final selection is based on weighted scores of CAT, GD-WAT-PI, behavioural assessment, academic merit, diversity and work experience.
