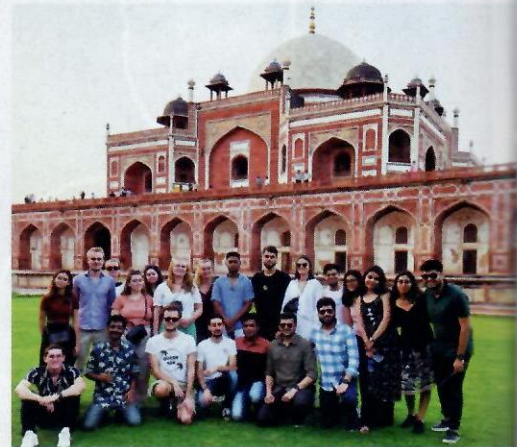
Cross-cultural learning and cooperation has become essential for any higher education institution as a result of increasing communication alternatives and internationalization. The international relationships cover a wide range of pursuits, including shared research, executive education, creation of academic content, teamwork on international initiatives, faculty exchange, and student exchange.

MDI Gurgaon has 90 international partnerships with triple-accredited B-schools and leading well-recognized Universities. In the latest QS Global MBA Ranking 2023, MDI Gurgaon has been ranked #41 in Asia and #201-250 globally. MDI recently added new partners like Nichols Business School USA, Deakin University Australia, Loughborough University UK, Swansea University UK, KEDGE Business School France, EM Normandie Business School France, Cankiri University Turkey, Powiślański University, Poland and a few more MoU's are in progress.

The institute strategically works on engagements of its faculty with partner Universities for teaching and research collaborations. This academic year, as part of the Student Exchange Program (SEP), 40% of the batch size of MDI Gurgaon went on outbound exchange, on the other hand, the campus welcomed nearly one-third of foreign students from partner institutions across the globe.

A number of international scholarships are available for the students of MDI who go on the exchange program to MDI's partner Universities/Business Schools. MDI students received the popular "Charpak Scholarship" a French government scholarship program for Indian students to study abroad and MDI students attended the term abroad under Erasmus grants at partner Universities. Ms. Priya Tekriwal from the 2022-24 batch received the Charpak Scholarship for term exchange in Sept 2022 at France University.

MDI Gurgaon's Internationalization objective is to



become a hub for international academics and students through its collaborative teaching, research, immersion and student exchange activities to imbibe best practices and keep them contemporary in the fast-changing workplace.
