Over the past few days, there has been some anxiety and concern after the Institute wrote to some candidates, who had earlier been offered provisional admission offers in PGDM / PGDM-HRM / PGDM-IB / PGDM-Business Analytics programmes for 2024-26, that "it would not be possible to accommodate them in the current 2024-26 batch," given that the dropout rate had fallen significantly this year, when compared to last few years.

Some, who may not have been familiar with the entire situation, have, however, made statements that don't do justice to MDI's credibility and integrity.

In the present context, in the larger interest of the students, MDI has taken a conscious call to offer guaranteed admission offers to all such students, who had earlier been offered provisional admission offers, but could not be accommodated in the current batch, for the year 2025-27.

These students would not be required to pay any increased fees – what would normally be applicable to the batch of 2025-27.

If, however, any of such students decides not to pursue the programme in 2025-27, he/she will be refunded the Rs 6 lakh caution money in full.
